Fabric

BOUCLE

Care & Cleaning

- Vacuum regularly: Use a soft brush attachment to gently remove dust and dirt.
- Spot clean: Blot spills immediately with a clean, damp cloth and mild soap.
- Avoid soaking: Do not overly wet the fabric.

Maintenance

- Professional cleaning: Schedule professional cleaning annually to maintain the fabric's appearance.
- Brush gently: Use a soft-bristled brush to maintain the texture of the boucle.



CASHMERE

Care & Cleaning

- Vacuum lightly: Use a low suction vacuum to clean dust and debris.
- Spot clean: Blot spills immediately with a clean, damp cloth and mild soap.
- Avoid water: Minimize water use to prevent watermarks and damage.

- Piling management: Use a cashmere comb or fabric shaver to gently remove any pills that may form on the surface.
- Avoid heat: Keep cashmere furniture away from direct heat sources, such as fireplaces.
- Handle gently: Avoid rough handling to prevent pilling and damage.



CORDUROY

Care & Cleaning

Leather

ANILINE LEATHER

Wood

SOLID WOOD

Care & Cleaning

Metal

STAINLESS STEEL

Others

FIBER GLASS

GLASS

RATTAN

Care & Cleaning

- Avoid harsh cleaners: Use a mild soap solution; avoid harsh chemicals and abrasive cleaners.

- Avoid excessive humidity: Keep rattan furniture in a well-ventilated area.



SILK

Care & Cleaning
